Musings...

Christianity was cradled in the bosom of Hebrew language and culture. The Hebrews lived in a world of dynamic images. Their word pictures were passionate, sometimes explosive. To the tidy Greek mind, they often seemed immoderate and exaggerated. Yet God chose the Hebrew language to introduce the Old Testament.

This year we focus on the Wisdom Literature, especially the *Proverbs of Solomon*. Many of the proverbs are simply random snapshot illustrations on any given topic across the entire range of right living. No doubt this was entirely acceptable to the Hebrew mind, but it complicates making a program!

We allow our speakers freedom to use a broad range of verses for their assigned themes. After praising Wisdom herself, topics often addressed in *The Proverbs* are labour, youth and the home, social relationships, speech, and moral purity. Wisdom shows us a path that leads onward and upward, shining “more and more unto the perfect day.”

Of special interest is the focus on *Ancient Landmarks*. This topic recognizes the 500th anniversary of Anabaptism in January of 2025; making the Anabaptist movement one of the longest-running conservative traditions in Christianity. We are not celebrating its existence. But we humbly need to know which landmarks have been important to its survival.
